has a tighter than normal weave. This is the safest, least toxic,
and most durable wick we know. Compare to Kevlar™.

Latest Stuff from **FLAMING SPARROW**

Monkeyfist Torch Heads, per pair:

- 3.5" - **\$50** – big mf Monkeyfists with huge spherical ball-like flames and extraordinary burn times.
 - 2.5" - **\$40** – more normal burn times with the same spherical flames. What torch-heads *should* look like.
 - 2" - **\$35** – small and fast – a unique poi look.
- Most common comment: "Ohh! They're so *cute!*"

Poi Leashes, per pair: **\$17**

With your choice of poly, Kevlar, or (soon) leather handles, and custom lengths of #20 ball-chain matched to your poi torches for a perfect fit.

Monkeyfist Fire Hammer/Dart: **\$40**

One 3.5" Monkeyfist torch head and one leash: 12" of #20 ball-chain, and 13' of woven 3/8" cotton or poly cord.
(Hammer leash alone: \$16)

Monkeyfist Fire Meteor: **\$60** (with 2.5" mf), **\$70** (with 3.5" mf)

Two Monkeyfist torch heads connected with a custom length of center rope of woven 3/8" poly or cotton cord. (Meteor leash alone: \$21)

Monkeyfist Meteors: **\$35** (non-fire)

A pair of 3.5" mf joined by 6-8' of cord, all made from a single length of 3/8" woven nylon/poly cord. Your choice of colors: solid red, blue, black, or white; or with a white stripe.

Our ball-chain is #20 grade (1/4"), and it and all connections and fittings have a 140 lb minimum working load.

Our wicks are made of knitted or woven para-aramid and fiberglass blends (comparable to Dupont's Kevlar).



DUVETYNE

What is it? It's a fire-resistant cloth and a quick and easy way to extinguish flaming torches. Much better than damp towels because it doesn't get moldy, requires no water, quickly smothers flame, is instantly ready for use, and packs and stores without special treatment. Just air-dry it and shake it out to remove soot and unspent fuel.

A few Duvy precautions:

—If you are extinguishing many props at once, rotate and turn the cloth to keep the heat from your hands.

—*Never wash Duvetyne*: that removes its fireproofness. (Keep a bucket of clean water around anyway, to cool burns and remove yucky foreign matter from open wounds.)

We carry the heavier, 16 oz Duvetyne, also known as Commando Cloth because when sewn into clothing it makes the wearer ninja-invisible at night and when skulking through the shadows. Get your skulk on!

Small Piece: \$5 (28" x 36"). Enough Duvetyne to put out poi, juggling torches, small fans, devil stick, or your face.

Large Piece: \$8 (56" x 36"). Enough Duvetyne to put out jump-ropes, big fans, a staff, wings, and almost your whole body.

Endless Piece: \$7/yd for anything over 5 yards. We'll cut it directly from a 56 inch wide 50-yard bolt. Get all ninja. Make hoodies for your favorite fire breathers. (Goth pot holders?)
